

Category 21: Literary Magazine Illustration

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Complete a hand-drawn illustration on plain 8 1/2-by-11-inch white paper to accompany the following poem.
- Scan your design and save as a PDF.
- Entries must be uploaded by 6 p.m. CDT Oct. 18, 2021.
- Indicate in a note on your paper where the poem should appear on the page in relation to the artwork.
- Do not use professional materials like art tape, screens, letters or construction paper.
- The illustration can be drawn either vertically or horizontally.
- You may use any medium you choose, including, but not limited to pencil, pen, charcoal, markers, pastels, watercolors, etc.
- Make a note on your page for the judges indicating the medium you used in case it is not apparent from the scanned copy.

DO NOT INCLUDE YOUR NAME OR SCHOOL NAME ON YOUR ENTRY.

HINTS:

- Adapt the art to the copy.
- Use originality in interpretation.
- Use simplicity and accuracy in design of illustration.
- Take the poem's placement into consideration.
