

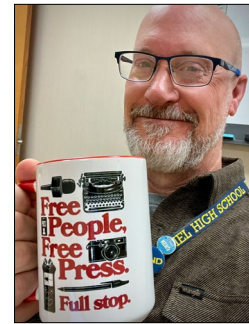
Summer's finally here. JEA is still here for you.

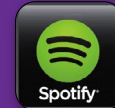
